Note: due to increased entries this year there has been some changes to the competition's format. Captains please read below and make your team aware of these changes.

With the large number of entries this year **it is important these rules are followed** as matches will be run on a tight schedule.

Format and rules

- Matches will be played over 2 courts with each player to play 3 sets on the day - one with each other member of their team.
- Each set will be first to 6 games with a tie break at 5 all.
- Games will be played with a 'short deuce' meaning that the second deuce of a game is a game point with the receiving team to nominate the side to which the server must serve on this point.
- Order of sets for the day will be as follows:

1st court	2nd court
Player 1 and Player 2	Player 3 and Player 4
Player 1 and Player 3	Player 2 and Player 4
Player 1 and Player 4	Player 2 and Player 3
- A horn will be blown at 1.25pm and 3.25pm. At such time a game or tie break already in progress must be completed after which players must promptly make way for the following match.
- Warm ups should last no longer than 5 minutes.
- The result of a match is first decided by number of sets won and then by games won.
- Teams will receive 1 point for each set won and 4 points for each match won. Points will be evenly split for any incomplete sets and for matches where no result has already been achieved.
- In the event of rained out semi finals, the higher placed team will progress.
- Winning captains are to write the result of the match on the score sheet posted on the notice board in the club house.
